This funding will be used to

- Implement strategies that support staff and students to achieve our schoolwide target of 80% of students achieving an A-C result on Semester 2 English report cards.
- Implement strategies that support staff and students to achieve our NAPLAN target in reading performance comparable to like schools and national results – National Minimum Standard, Mean Score, Upper Two Bands.
- Implement strategies that support staff and students to achieve our schoolwide target of 90% of students in Prep to Year 2 meet or exceed our reading targets.
- Implement strategies that support staff and students to achieve Progressive Achievement Test in Reading (PAT R) Year 2-6 targets (23% Stanine 1-3, 54% Stanine 4-6, 23% Stanine 7-9).
- Improve staff data literacy skills and precision of pedagogy through collaboration and deprivatising of classroom practice.

Our initiatives include

- Implement high yield, precise targeted teaching strategies informed by the analysis of student results including current and historical results (John Hattie).
- Undertake regular collaborative review of student data using our Data Assessment Schedule to inform whole school intervention, extension and professional development program (Lyn Sharratt).
- Develop systems and processes to support growing a professional learning community (Dufour and Dufour).
